

Room 112: 4th Grade Assignments for March 31st - April 20th

Ms. Chan (Math)	<p>Students are practicing the math skills that they have worked on in last week's math packet. This will help them solidify their understanding of those skills. Students are to complete the assignments from Pearson Realize, 70 Freckle problems a week, and 3 rounds of XtraMath a day (or Blue Streak for students who have Blue Streak accounts). There are also games that I assigned on Pearson Realize that relates to their work.</p> <p>There are two options that you and your child can choose from on Pearson Realize. One option is to complete Practice Buddy for each lesson. The other option is to print the PDF files for each lesson, and then turn in the completed work when school resumes. Please select one option or the other. For example, do not choose Practice Buddy for Lesson 9-1 and then complete PDF files for Lesson 9-2. However, your child may still play the math games even if they have selected to work on the PDF files.</p> <p>The beauty of Practice Buddy is that it allows students to check their answers before they go onto the next problem. It will alert the students if their answers are wrong. Practice Buddy also gives students their scores immediately after they completed it. The beauty of the PDF files is that your child does not have to stare at a screen since you are printing them. It also includes enrichment and problem solving activities.</p> <p>To find the Practice Buddy assignments and math games on Pearson Realize, have your child log-in and click on "Classes." Then find the playlist with the title, "Room 112: March 31 - April 20 Assignments." If you are looking for the PDF files, it will be under the title, "Room 112- Another Option for March 31 - April 20."</p> <p>Below is a sample schedule on when each assignment should be completed.
