Ms. Chan (Math)	<p>Students are to complete the assignments from Pearson Realize, 70 Freckle problems a week, and 3 rounds of XtraMath a day (or Blue Streak for students who have Blue Streak accounts).</p> <p>Like the assignments before this, students will have the option to complete Practice Buddy on Pearson Realize or download the PDF files (also located on Pearson Realize). However, this time, the work completed on the PDF files must be submitted through Google Classroom and not by email. Online assessments can only be completed online.. If you choose to have your child complete the PDF assignments, please have them complete the online assessments on Pearson. The "playlist" title on Pearson Realize for the Practice Buddy assignments is "<i>Room 115: Practice Buddy Assignments for April 21st - May 4th.</i>" The "playlist" title for PDF Files on Pearson Realize is "<i>Room 115: PDF File Assignments for April 21st -May 4th (Another Option).</i>" Please select one option or the other. For example, do not choose Practice Buddy for Lesson 10-1 and then complete PDF files for Lesson 10-2.</p> <p>Students will use the textbook with me on Google Meet. We will do one lesson and practice together from their textbook, and then they will work on that same lesson on Practice Buddy/PDF files independently (or with some guidance from you).</p> <p>A digital version of the book is available if you did not get a chance to pick up the hard copy (Watch this video to pull up the digital book: https://www.loom.com/share/7ba170f6129b4026a219a2877d759a9d). Math textbook work will NOT be submitted to me since we will be completing it together.</p> <p>Below is a sample schedule on when each assignment should be completed. Also we will have weekly Newsela articles and quizzes to complete for homework and daily Raz Kids reading and quizzes to take in lieu of our weekly reading log and response questions. I will post all work on Google Classroom and students will complete the Newsela quizzes on a Google Form. Please do not email any classwork during 4th quarter. It needs to be completed and submitted on Google Classroom or online (Raz Kids or Freckle). Students will also take Storyworks quizzes online in Google Classroom.</p>
